WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Health Form (mandatory) – turn in to Mr. Rutherford ASAP.

Payment if you haven't already paid.

Scout uniform including neckerchief (please bring it on a hanger)

Scout shorts and scout socks if you already own them

T-shirts (including troop 8 shirt)

Shorts (Bring long pants if you are taking climbing or COPE or lifesaving)

Socks & underwear

Shoes (recommend two pairs)

Sandals

Poncho or rain gear

Swim trunks (street wear not allowed in pool)

Sleeping bag, bed sheet (for hot nights) and pillow

Notebook and pens or pencils (for classes)

Boy Scout handbook

Flashlight (with fresh batteries)

Cup

Pocketknife

Toiletries (toothbrush, towels (2), soap, etc.)

Sunscreen and Insect Repellant

Spending money for Trading Post

Camera (optional)

Fishing tackle (optional – age 13 and up requires TN fishing license)

Don't bring anything from the "forbidden items list." This includes cell phones, electronics, mp3 players, sheath knives, fireworks, glass containers, or unapproved reading materials. If in doubt as to whether something is forbidden, ask the Scoutmaster.

General Notes

- Some scouts will be taking classes which require a fee to be paid above and beyond the base price for a week at camp. For example, rifle merit badge costs \$10 to defray the cost of ammunition, and motorboating merit badge costs \$10 to defray the cost of fuel. If you owe class fees, you should have received an e-mail from the troop. These are payable upon our arrival to camp.
